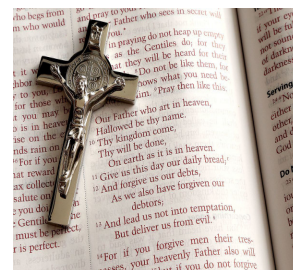
Programme of preparation for parents of children preparing for their First Communion continues on line with Mass today at 12.00 noon.
