9 am Culmullen and 10 am in Dunshaughlin, both Masses open to 50 people

Starting Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May Masses,

Saturday Vigils: Culmullen 6 pm Dunshaughlin 7 pm

Sundays: Dunshaughlin 9 am and 12 noon. Culmullen 10.30 am

Government stipulates that only 50 people can attend Mass.

Social distancing is to be observed as per seating arrangements, masks must be worn, and please sanitize hands as you enter the Church.

We invite Readers and Special Ministers to be available for Masses, a rota will be available

No collection during the Mass, we ask collectors and stewards to organise collection at doors after Mass. Please come early for Mass as only 50 can be admitted.

Only **one** intention will be taken for each Mass in Dunshaughlin and Culmullen.

First Saturday and fourth Sunday in Dunshaughlin Church.

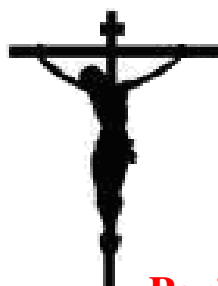
Second Sunday in Culmullen.
